Ambedkar Jayanti or Bhim Jayanti is an annual festival observed on 14 April to commemorate B. R. Ambedkar, Indian polymath, father of India's constitution, civil rights activists. It marks Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar's birthday, who was born on 14 April 1891. Since 2015, it has been observed as an official public holiday throughout India. Ambedkar Jayanti is celebrated not just in India but all around the world. Ambedkar struggled for equality throughout his life; hence, his birthday is celebrated as '**Equality Day**' in India. The demand to declare this day as "International Equality Day" goes to the United Nations.
