36% of IITGn grads have foreign exposure

Ahmedabad: Nearly 36% of the students of IIT Gandhinagar who will be getting their degrees at the convocation on Sunday have had foreign exposure. They have either interned in another country or studied there. They have even presented papers and participated in contests or training projects. Also, almost 90% of the students have internship experience.

At the second convocation of the institute, 104 students of BTech and 10 students of MTech will be awarded degrees. Prof Anil Kakodkar, Homi Bhabha chair professor at Bhabha Atomic Research Centre (BARC), will be the chief guest at the event. The institute will also award 28 medals to achievers in academic, sports, leadership and community service.

Out of the 104 graduating students, 14 have opted to go for higher studies, states a note from the institute. The students will take up M Tech or research programmes at institutes such as Carnegie Mellon University, Purdue University, Texas A & M University, Duke University, University of Texas, Cornell University, Brown University, University of Washington and University of California.
