Students of IIT, Gandhinagar, are all set to rock their campus through the annual cultural festival 'BIITHCHRON-2010' which will be held on January 23 and 24.

More than 1000 students from across the country will participate in the show.

According to Sarthak Jain, convener of the event, the occasion will be held for the second time, after its debut last year. He said that this year the students have already started various schemes like blood donation camps, spreading technical literacy in city schools and colleges and preservation of natural heritage.

This year the event's major attraction will be guests such as Dilip Chabbaria who is known for modifying cars around the world. Chabbaria will be giving a presentation on how to modify cars.

Apart from him bollywood actor Irfan Khan will also address the students.

The event will also include programmes like 'Jobless' wherein mock interviews, group discussion and mock curriculum vitae will be presented. Further, there will be a workshop on ethical hacking presented by Sunny Vaghela.

"A theatre group formed by students of IIT-Bombay will be performing in the event. While STIVA, the team of well-known choreographer Syamak Dabar will also perform," said Jain.

There will also be the war cry of rock bands on the campus in which the country's most popular band 'Parikrama' will perform along with five other groups.

The organisers are expecting around 2000 visitors and more than 1000 participants from almost all the IITs and 40 engineering colleges from the state and other parts of the country.
