

IIT Gn's event to market innovations of bright minds

It aims to bring together investors and entrepreneurs on a platform

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A three-day intensive programme called 'Tech2Impact' has been organised by IITGn to help people who have a passion for technology embark on the journey of commercialisation. It has been scheduled from July 24 to July 26, which is to be held at the institute. The programme intends to enable the translation of technology to businesses by bringing together inventors and people with complementary skills and by providing them the necessary expertise.

Participants will get a chance to be part of a team that commercialises a technology, helping them gain experience, brain-storm for ideas and develop ad-hoc leadership skills and decision making under severe

time constraints. The programme will also focus on team information, technology bazaar, making use of technology to build an effective business plan and pitching the plan in front of investors and accomplished entrepreneurs.

Advisor of Intellectual Property and Entrepreneurship at IIT Gandhinagar, Dr Hiran Vedam said, "The programme is conceived to be extremely hands-on and gives participants a chance to be part of a team that can take technology to the market."

He added, "The participants will remain connected to each other even after the programme to work together and take the technology to the market. IITGn and its partners will lend support in various possible ways during the entire process of innovation."

Applications for the programme would be accepted via their web portal, enabling interaction and evaluation. It is open for all the technology-driven people.
