

Engineers to come up with global tech ideas

To discuss topics across a range of engineering fields in three-day event

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Engineers from India as well as China will be a part of a three-day gathering that will take place under the first Indo-Chinese Young Engineering Leaders' Conclave (ICON-1) facilitated by the Indian Academy of Engineering (INAE) and the

Chinese Academy of Engineering (CAE) from October 7 to 9. The meet will discuss pioneering technical work and leading research across a range of engineering fields of global importance

As many as, 28 Indian and 13 Chinese delegates will be participating in the event, through technical presentations, group discussions, and brain-storming sessions that would help develop important recommendations.

"The conclave provides an opportunity for healthy growth of engineering

education, industry, research and development in India and China," said Pranab Mohapatra, who will be one of the co-coordinators of the event.

"The themes of the conclave areas are extremely important topics for both India and China. The presentations and recommendations coming out of these sessions will be helpful to researchers at different levels pertaining to the technological field," he said.

The discussions in the event will revolve around four themes - safety, healthcare devices, big data, and clean water.

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
