

# Counterstrike comes alive at IITGn's Blithchron

Two students of Indian Institute of Technology, Gandhinagar, brought the popular computer game Counterstrike alive at Blithchron 2015 by inventing a similar game called Laser Assassins. The duo, Punit Kumar and Sargam Jain designed unique laser jackets that detect the number of laser shots a player has been inflicted with. "We have attached the laser gun with the jacket which is run by a few circuits. On nine hits, the jacket stops powering the laser gun and the person is out of the game," said Kumar. They made six jackets for Rs 4,000. Over 40 teams participated in the game.

The IITGn dance group performed using Relispray and fire, creating a visual extravaganza for the audience.

The first day of the two-day fest had over 10,000 college students participate. Events like LAN Gaming event – 'Skirmish' saw the biggest participation.
