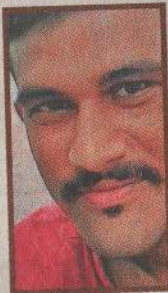
I think Section 144 has been implemented for Swine Flu. It is an Epidemic Act which has been implemented for stopping the spread of virus.
