

# IIT-Gn campus-warming on July 1

IIT-Gn is set to shift to its 400 acre permanent campus on the banks of the Sabarmati River at Palaj village in Gandhinagar. “We’ll move to the new campus on July 1 and will try to start some classes from mid-July,” said institute director Prof Sudhir Jain. He said the building would be one of the swankiest campuses of the country with an array of luxury amenities. The original move was scheduled for mid-December, but the project was delayed. For the past few years, IIT-Gn has been functioning from a temporary facility at Vishwakarma Engineering College in Chandkheda.
