

Meet at IITGn on defence, security

Noted scientist VK Saraswat to give talk

Ahmedabad: NITI Aayog member and former chief of Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO) VK Saraswat will deliver a talk on India's technologies in the area of 'Defence and Internal Security' at the Indian Institute of Technology, Gandhinagar (IITGN)'s annual technical summit 'Amalthea 16' on October 22-23.

Saraswat is credited with playing a key role in the development of Prithvi, Dhanush and Prahaar missiles. He is also

the man behind Liquid Propulsion Indian Rockets.

He added new dimensions to the defence scenario with the successful test-firing of Agni-5 and SHOURYA missiles and the induction of INS Arihant.
