IIT-Gn signs MoU with Kyrgyz University

The Indian Institute of Technology, Gandhinagar, (IIT-Gn) signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with International University of Innovation Technologies of Kyrgyz Republic on Tuesday to promote cooperation in education and academic research.
