

BTech-MTech, dual degree courses at IITGn soon

Ahmedabad: Students at Indian Institute of Technology - Gandhinagar (IITGn) can now opt for dual degree courses by pursuing engineering in two different streams and studying for an extra year. The institute will also offer one joint BTech-MTech course of five years. IITGn director Sudhir Jain announced the development at the sixth convocation ceremony held on Saturday.

While addressing the media,

Jain added that the institute will also offer courses wherein its student get degrees from both IITGn and Japan Advanced Institute of Science and Technology (JAIST). Selected students will get an opportunity to study at JAIST for a year after completing BTech at IITGn.

IITGn is betting high on monthly donations from its alumni. Rishab Anand of Electrical Engineering bagged five medals, the highest by any graduating student in this batch, and Rishabh Jain of Civil Engineering bagged four.
